

How to measure:

All our pricing is per panel.

Two panels make a one complete pair.

Finished length of panel:

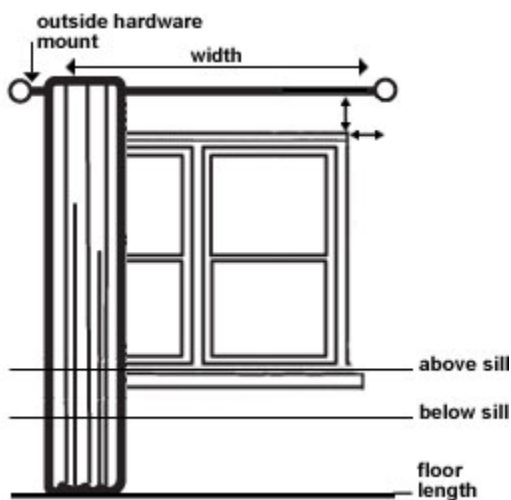
Pleated:

- Measure from the bottom of the drapery ring to the floor (the most common length for drapes is ½" above the floor)

Grommet:

- Measure from the top of the curtain rod to the floor;
- Add 1-12" to this measurement for grommet;

Finished width of panel:



1. Measure the width of window from outside molding to outside molding.
2. Add 16" to this dimension for providing ample overlap and return.
3. To establish one panel width – divide this total dimension by 2.

Rings (drapery hooks are pre-installed on each panel):

Number of widths	1	1 1/2	2	2 1/2	3
Pleated panels – solid fabric	7	9	12	14	17
Pleated panel – striped fabric	6	8	10	12	14
Pleated sheers	8	12	14	16	20

Lining:

Standard lining – adds fullness to drapes and provides moderate protection against sunlight damage;

Blackout lining – adds fullness to drapes and blocks 99% of light; also excellent for bedrooms and media rooms.
